You will have time to snorkel, swim and paddle surf in a memorable setting.

- Hands-On Learning in Marine Technology: Gain practical experience with advanced marine equipment, fostering a deeper understanding of underwater robotics and its applications.
- Interdisciplinary Skill Development: Learn to operate an ROV to integrate concepts from engineering, marine biology, computer science, and environmental science.
- Real-World Research Applications: Collect data and observe underwater ecosystems.
- Problem-Solving and Critical Thinking: Operating an ROV involves adapting to challenges in real time, sharpening analytical and decision-making skills.
- Preparation for Industry Careers: Prepares you for careers in marine research, environmental monitoring, underwater archaeology and offshore engineering.

We started using a Fifish ROV a few years back in Meet the sea and we were very impressed with the applications it immediately had in our daily activities. We share with you some of the most interesting challenges we faced back then but we really want you to be in control of the ROV and draw your own conclusions

Abilities:	No prior experience in ROV handling assumed.
Transfer	Boat pickup from hotel jetty if staying at Hotel Tagomago or private coach transfer if staying in any other of our hotels.

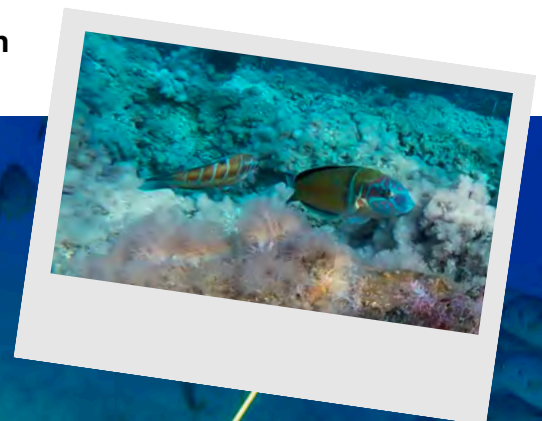

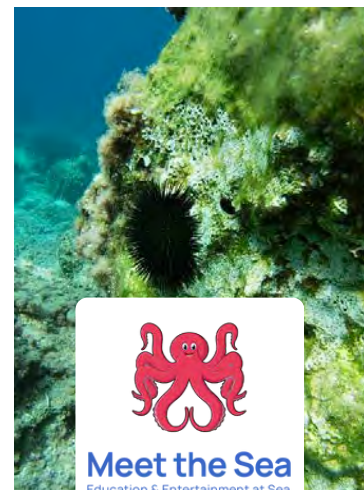

PADDLE SURFING THE WILD NORTH OF IBIZA

Duration:	4-5 hours
Equipment	We provide paddle surfs, life vests, mask & snorkel, food, water and fruit juices. The paddle surfing adventure is organised and led by paddle surfing instructors that are familiar with this particular spot.
Abilities:	No previous experience in paddle surfing necessary.
Transfer	Private coach from the hotel and back. Scenic route that takes us to the north of Ibiza, specifically to the stunning bay of Portinatx near the village of San Juan.
What to bring	Bathing suit, towel, T-shirt, waterproof shoes, sunscreen, refillable water bottle.

We choose the north of the island for this experience for what it represents in terms of its atmosphere, its beauty and its history. The imaginary line that divides the island in two from Santa Eulalia to San Antonio is the threshold that leads us to the lesser-known side of Ibiza. Bright red soil, olive, fig and carob trees are everywhere. We make our way, surrounded by a silence we did not expect, to the turquoise waters of S'illot des renclí, only a short distance from Cala Xarraca.

S'illot des Renclí, Cala des Xuclar and the hidden creeks in the bay of Portinatx are some of the gems we discover along the way.



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OBJECTIVES

- To learn the basics of paddle surfing with the guidance of our instructor. A 45-minute introductory briefing will take place at the beach and you will be closely monitored throughout the 4-hour experience.
- -Snorkelling material will be included and part of our journey as we reach with our paddle surfs hidden coves ideally suited to underwater discovery. Our guide will point out some of the underwater fauna as we visit specific spots during our journey.



KAYAKING: THE ICONIC ES VEDRÀ

Difficult choice of routes! The wonderful guide created by www.ibiza.travel shows us the dramatic scenery that a lot of the proposed routes offer. Distances vary greatly and we have had to adapt some of them to a reasonable distance to allow for snorkelling breaks and our own time limits.

Cala Salada to Ses Balandres, Es Portitxol to the lighthouse of Moscarter or Benirrás to Es Canaret are perhaps our favourites but the historical significance and beauty of Es Vedrá is at the top of our list. We always prioritise factors such as scenery (rock formation, water colours) biodiversity and sea depth (to facilitate snorkelling).

Kayaking is probably one of the best ways to explore our stunning coastline. We love that the quiet nature of kayaking minimizes noise pollution, which can disrupt marine life and ecosystems. Kayaks also allow us to approach shallow areas without damaging delicate ecosystems or stirring up sediment. Above all, they truly make us feel like a sea creature for a few hours, revelling in our natural habitat. What better way to empathize with our oceans?

Equipment	We provide Kayaks, life vest, food, water and fruit juices.
Abilities:	Some experience in Kayaking advisable but not strictly necessary.
Transfer	Private coach from the hotel and back. Possibility of boat transfer if sea conditions and choice of route allow it.
What to bring	Bathing suit, towel, T-shirt, waterproof shoes, sunscreen, refillable water bottle.



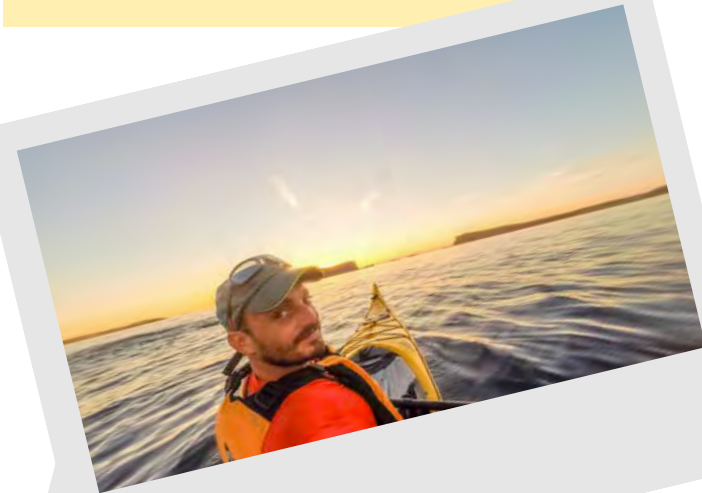

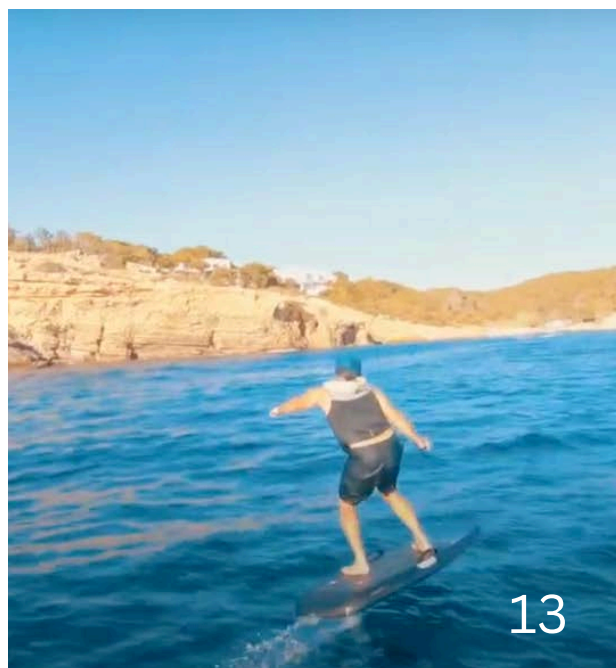
TECHNOLOGY AND THE SEA I: FLITEBOARD EFOIL, JETSURF AND AWAKE SURFBOARDS

We have selected the fantastic setting of Cala Comte to enjoy the natural reserve of the island of S'illa des bosc. BEACH-HOPPING JEEP JOURNEY

The challenge for our team was to select the best among all the beaches in Ibiza with at least one in the North, South, East and West coast. Once that was accomplished, we set out to select the most attractive roads and villages on the way to our destination.

During our tour you will enjoy the rural roads that take us through some of the most charismatic villages of the island that have escaped the attention of mass tourism. Olive, carob and almond trees rooted in bright red soil surrounded by ancient stone walls. Cubic white houses dotting the pine covered hills and dusty quiet roads. And, in the end, turquoise waters await glistening.

We selected open jeeps as the best way to enjoy the smell and feel of the air, salt and heat of the island.

Famous for its spectacular sunsets, Cala Benirrás is a key beach in the north of the island.



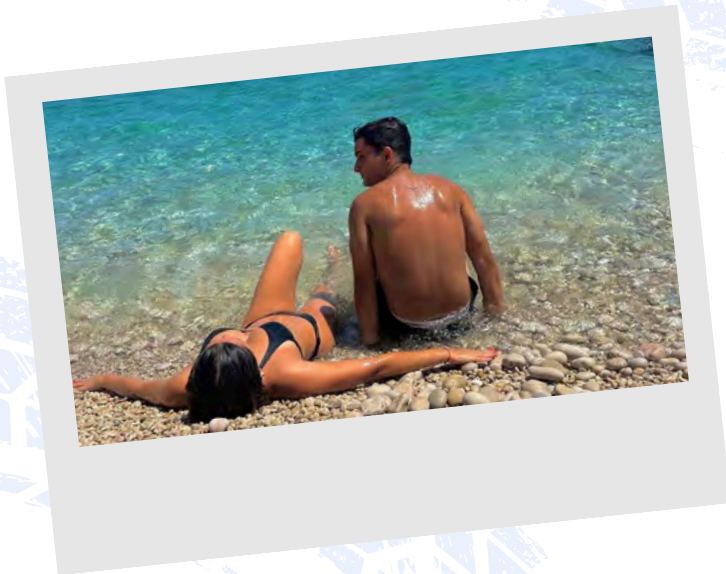
San Carlos village

DAY TRIP TO FORMENTERA

Formentera, the smaller of the two main Pitiusas (Islands of Pines as the greeks called them) is home to pristine waters and white sands. It is also home to a rich marine biodiversity that we explore by snorkelling in the best spots the island has to offer. In 1999, the meadows of *Posidonia Oceanica* existing between Ibiza and Formentera and belonging to the Natural Park of Ses Salines were declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Duration:	8 hours
Equipment	We provide all the equipment you will need for your snorkelling expedition (mask, snorkel, life vests, additional flotation devices, mineral water, and of course, lunch and dessert)
Transfer	Boat transfer from the port of Ibiza town to Formentera.
What to bring	Bathing suit, towel, T-shirt, sunscreen, refillable water bottle.



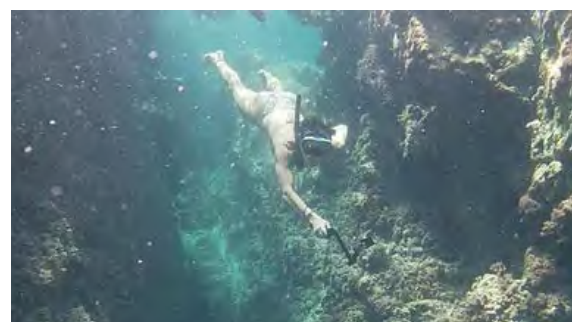
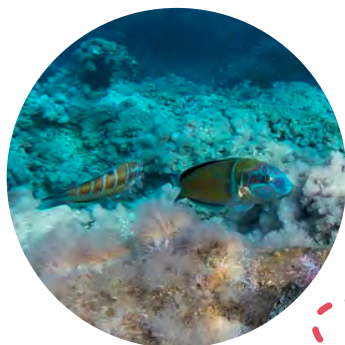


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Throughout the day, we enjoy a unique natural scenery while learning and snorkelling. One of the best possible ways to enjoy Formentera and create a memorable day at sea. We drop anchor in several of the spots presented below and select them based on sea conditions on the day. A wonderful emotional, academic and athletic experience.



Meadows of *Posidonia oceanica* or Neptune grass, Octopus, Peacock wrasse, Rainbow wrasse, Painted comber, Salema, spotted sea hare (*Aplysia dactylomela*), sea cucumbers (*Holothuria*), gobies, sea urchins, and quite a few more that you can find in our comprehensive list of approximately 150 different species



OBJECTIVES

- The content of the activity can be adapted to a more detailed, in-depth academic endeavour, but we certainly want to share an experience that allows you to enjoy the singular beauty of the waters of Formentera and its rich biodiversity.
- To observe in their natural habitat a considerable number of marine species and to develop our skills in observing, recording and analysing marine life.
- To understand marine ecosystems and in particular the presence and importance of *Posidonia oceanica* or Neptune grass in the island. To develop our understanding of the impact of human activities on the environment.
- To explore geological formations such as caves, reefs, cliffs and their influence on marine diversity. To learn about the role played by marine reserves and how they are managed.

MEET THE SEA SUNSET BOAT TRIP

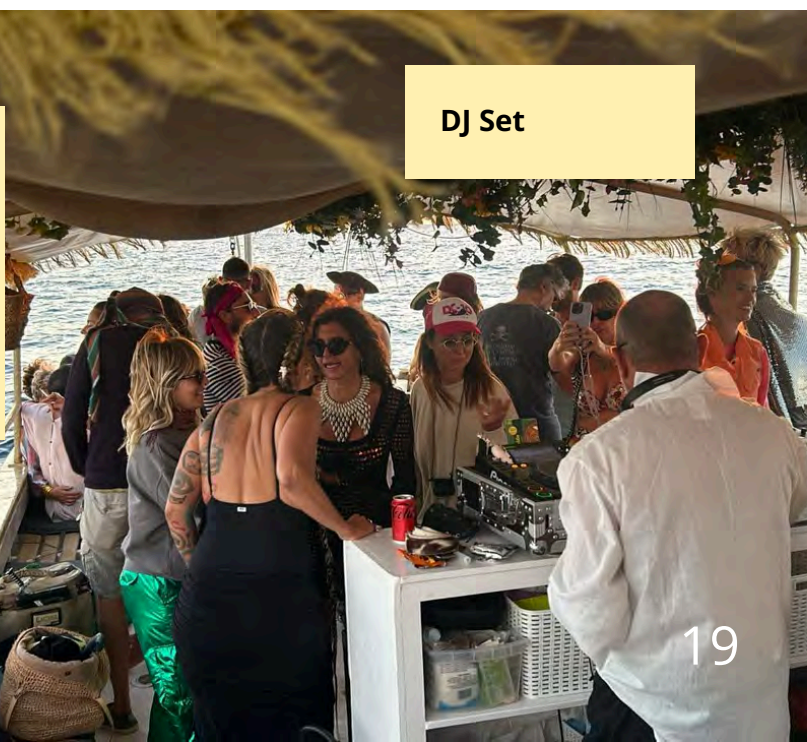

Transfer	Boat pickup from hotel jetty if staying at Hotel Tagomago or private coach transfer if staying in any other of our hotels.
What to bring	Bathing suit, towel, T-shirt, waterproof shoes, sunscreen. Perhaps a light jumper or jacket in the months of April, May, October and November.

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OBJECTIVES

- To understand Ibiza's unique identity: Learn how the island's history, geography, and artistic influences have shaped its distinct fashion culture.
- To appreciate local craftsmanship: Discover the role of traditional techniques, such as embroidery and weaving, in creating iconic Adlib fashion.
- To find inspiration for self-expression: Experiment with and incorporate Ibiza's bohemian and free-spirited aesthetic into your personal style.
- To immerse in the sensory delight of Ibiza's lively fashion scene, making the shopping experience fun and memorable.



The Old town's traditional whitewashed architecture and relaxed Mediterranean lifestyle inspired the iconic "Adlib" fashion style, emphasizing natural fabrics, flowing designs, and a commitment to comfort and authenticity. Adlib fashion, meaning "as you please," was formalized by designer Smilja Mihailovitch, blending local craftsmanship with global influences.



Ibiza's fashion scene today retains its bohemian roots while embracing modern trends, making it a hotspot for unique boutiques, vintage stores, and globally renowned designers. The Old Town of Ibiza is home to some of our favourite vintage and trendy shops: Can Vinyes and their use of traditional esparto or halfah grass for a great beach basket or stylish hat or the boutiques along the Carrer de sa Creu. And of course, a break at one of our favourite tapas bar as we head up Ses Taules into Dalt Vila.

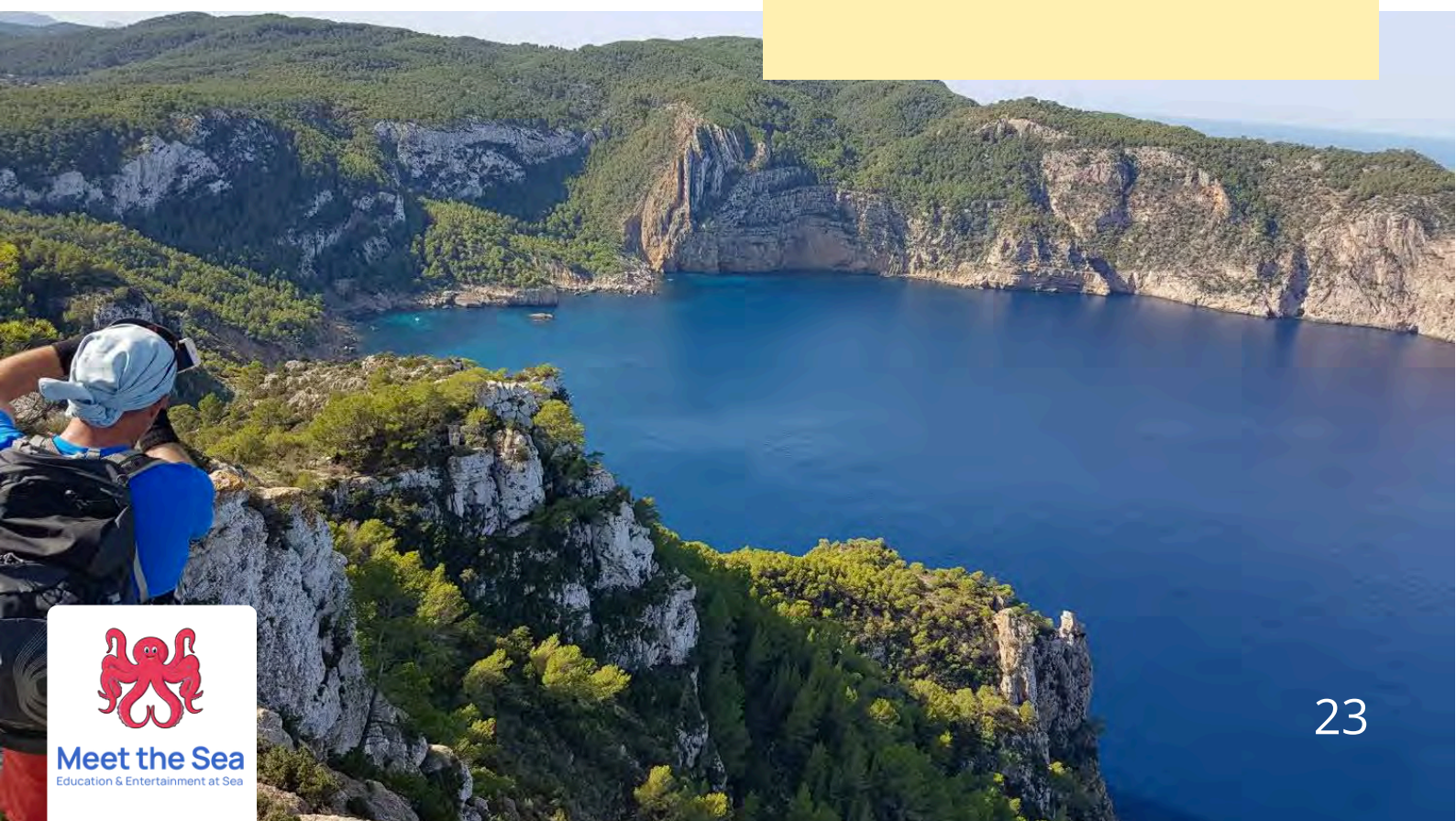
HIKING & FLORA DISCOVERY... AND NATURAL POOL

Hiking is one of the sports that locals favour in Ibiza! Our stunning views from the top of the hills, rich flora, pine scented trails and red soil are just some of the attractions. We want to share with you the diverse locations where flowers, plants and herbs find their optimal ecosystem: coastal plants that appear between rocks, species that prosper in sand dunes or those that benefit from the proximity of cultivated fields... before we enjoy a final dip in a natural pool.

Duration:	4-5 hours
Equipment	We provide you with a light but energetic outdoor lunch and dessert, mineral water.
Transfer	If in Ibiza: Private coach to the area of our activity (Ses Salines, Es cubells, or North of the island). If in Formentera: Ferry to Formentera from Ibiza and Bicycle, scooter or private coach to hiking location.
What to bring	Hiking shoes, light jacket (possibly), sunscreen, refillable water bottle. Bathing suit optional if you want to enjoy a swim in the sea after our hike.

OBJECTIVES

- To identify most of the species that we encounter during our hike in the rich diversity offered by both, Ibiza and Formentera. Please see partial list below.
- We have designed, with the guidance of our local hiking expert, an experience that combines a highly photographic scenery with a culturally enriching display of beautiful floral species.
- To capitalise on the opportunity to take wonderful photos of nature along the division of cliffs and sea.

INTRODUCTION TO COMPETITIVE SAILING

In partnership with the Yacht clubs of Es Nautic in Sant Antoni de Portmany and Club Náutico de Ibiza we provide a hands-on introduction to the world of competitive sailing. We sail from either the port of Ibiza or the port of San Antonio, depending on prevailing winds, onboard a cruising sailboat guided by a team leader expert in racing. During our four hours at sea we learn about the fundamentals of sailing and racing strategies with each student getting their turn at the helm.



Duration:	4 hours
Equipment	We provide a selection of sailing boats (12 crew each, including skipper) to accommodate your group, life vests and learning materials.
Transfer	Private coach to yacht club.
Ability	As it is an introductory experience, it is apt for all levels and no sailing knowledge is assumed.
What to bring	Shorts or light trousers, light jumper or sailing jacket, waterproof shoes. Sunscreen refillable water bottle.

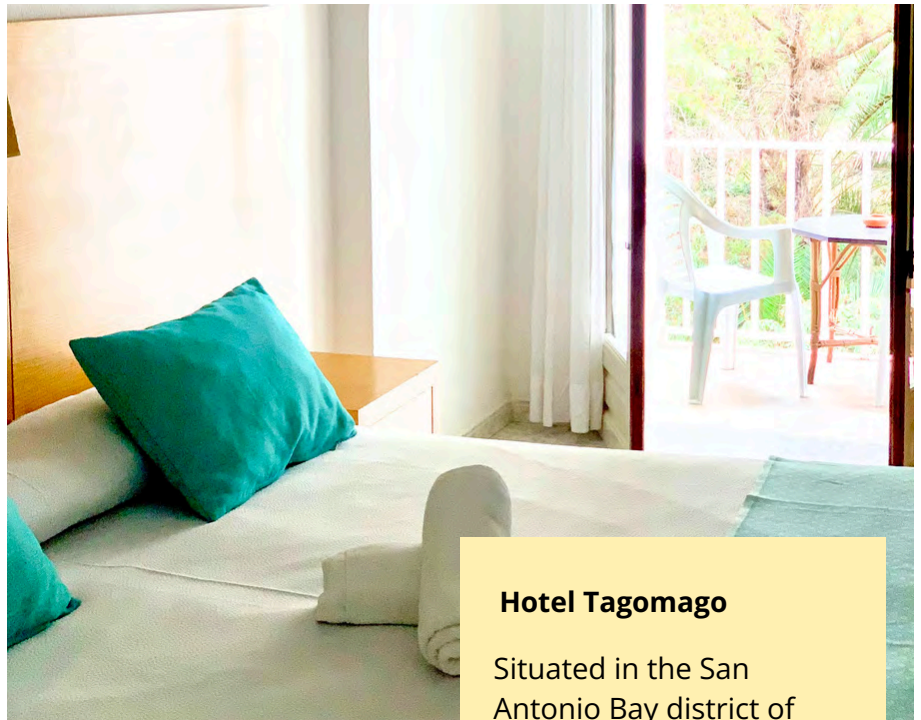
OBJECTIVES

- To understand the fundamentals of sailing: Points of sail, boat parts and structure, knots, sail trim and "rules of the road".
- To participate in a regatta to apply racing strategies previously explained by our racing expert.
- To acquire a "sense of sea" by interpreting wind and waves in order to feel more comfortable at sea in any situation.
- To strengthen leadership skills by commanding a sailing crew, decision making in adversity and self-assurance at sea.



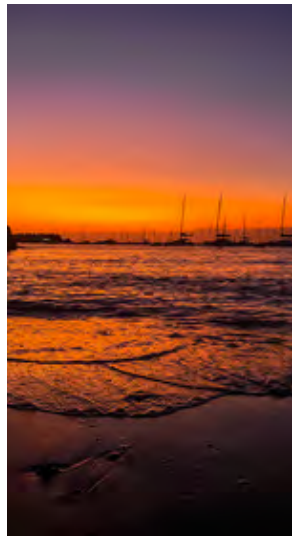


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Hotel Tagomago

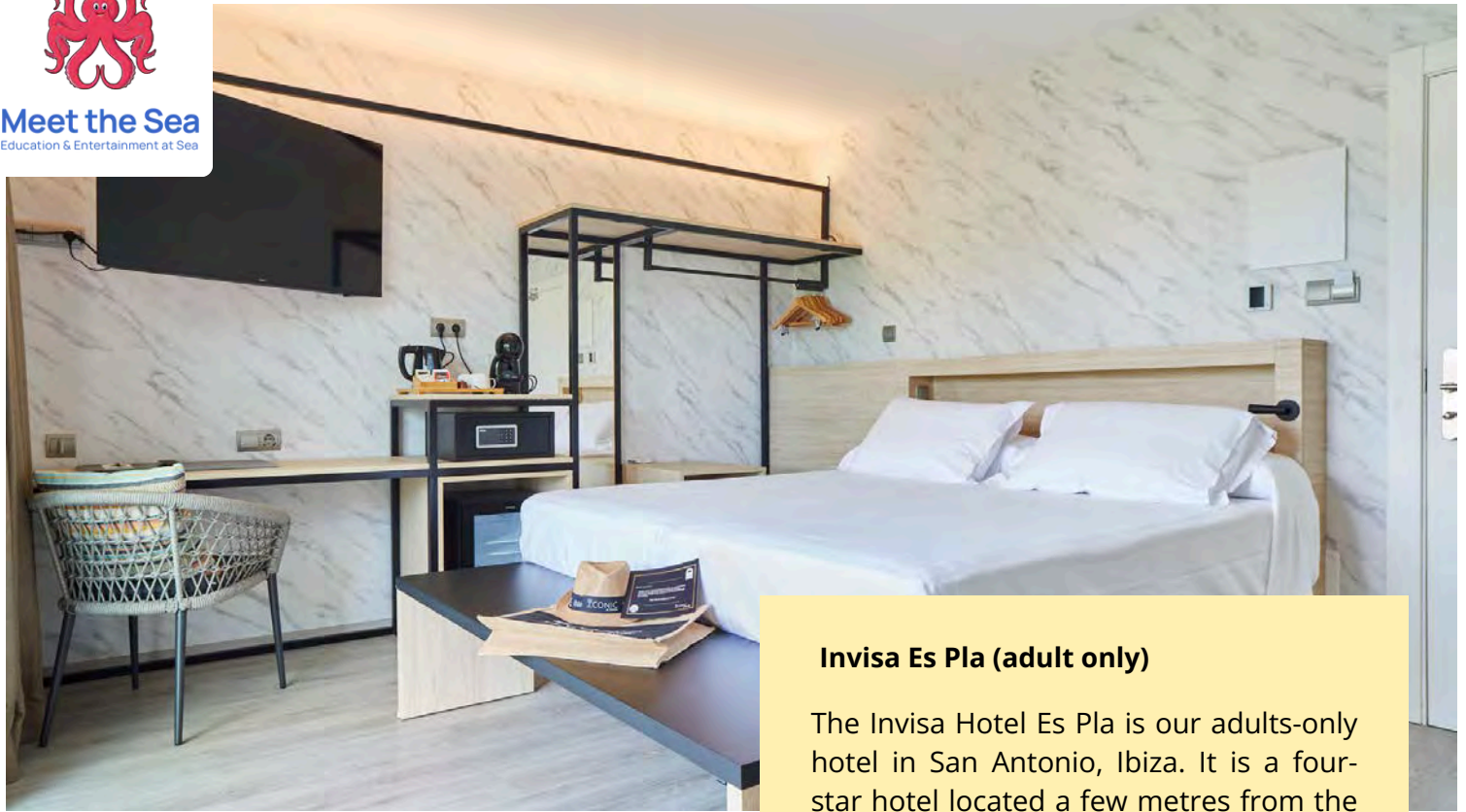

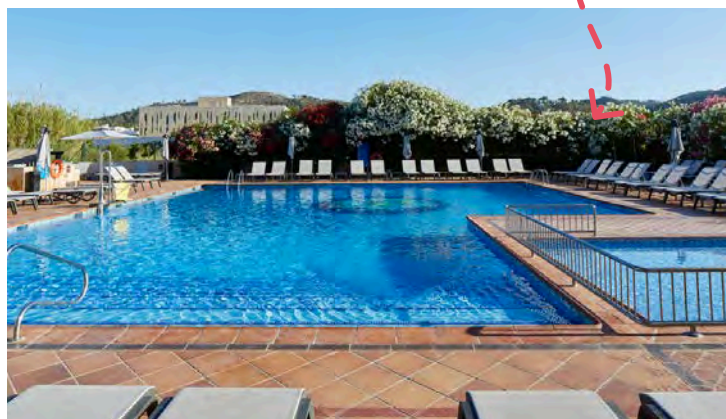
